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K-2 Science Kids - Mondays

K-2 Rising Road Runners Club - Mondays

Rising New York Road Runners is a free, nationwide program that helps youth develop the ability, confidence, and desire to be physically active for life. We take a developmental approach to physical education that's focused on a student's age, needs, and ability. Our

research-based program consists of games and activities that make it fun to learn - and teach - the fundamental movement skills at the heart of running and most other sports. Students will participate in physical activities such as running, stretching, and walking while earning incentives throughout the year for the miles they complete.

K-2 STEM Club - Thursdays

This club is a fun way to have learners find interest in science, technology, engineering and math with different hands-on explorations and different experiments where students will learn new concepts and apply them to their learning.

K-2 Lego Club - Thursdays

Lego club fosters and encourages children to have fun while developing teamwork and problem solving skills.
